SCHOOL UNIFORM

The new school uniform can be worn from September 2011. The introductory period for the new uniform is three years so by September 2014 all girls will be required to wear the new uniform. No mixing of old and new uniform is allowed; a complete new uniform will need to be bought if you wish to wear any of the new items. The rules regarding the old uniform are unaltered.

The only major change to the compulsory PE uniform is the hoodie which is now navy and burgundy. Other changes are only minor, mainly introducing the official school logo and removing green from the uniform except within the tartan of the PE kilt. Girls are therefore allowed to mix the old and the new PE uniforms. There is also a new waterproof jacket which is an optional item.

INDOOR WEAR:

Skirt: regulation pleated grey skirt (years 5 & 6); regulation straight grey skirt (years 7-11). Year 7 girls may wear either straight or pleated skirt. Length should be no shorter than a palm's width above the knee.

Blouse: regulation white blouse with burgundy buttons and cuff trim. Long sleeved for winter with option of short sleeves for summer. The shirt may be worn outside the skirt but, if a jumper is being worn, the shirt must not be visible below the jumper.

Jumper: regulation v-neck burgundy jumper

Science overall: regulation long sleeved navy blue

Tights: opaque plain black or natural tights

Socks: short white socks only. These must show above the shoe.

Shoes: plain black shoes, with a solid sole, low heel (no more than 3cm) and good foot support. Ballet pump style shoes are not appropriate.

Apron: a wipe clean or machine washable cookery apron of any colour/design

PE UNIFORM:

Hoodie: regulation blue hoodie, with girls' name embroidered by Shepherd & Woodward

Tracksuit bottoms: regulation blue tracksuit bottoms

Cycling shorts: regulation navy blue

Polo shirt: regulation burgundy, with girls' name embroidered by Shepherd and Woodward

Kilt: regulation tartan kilt

Socks: regulation burgundy socks

Leotard: plain black

Swimsuit: plain black

COMPULSORY PE EQUIPMENT:

Kit bag: regulation from Shepherd & Woodward with girls' name on outside

ADDITIONAL PE ITEMS: (not compulsory)

Waterproof top: regulation blue and maroon waterproof from Shepherd and Woodward

Footless tights: black

Lacrosse stick bag

OUTDOOR WEAR:

Coat: plain black coat only

Hats, scarves and gloves: any colour item may be worn to and from school, but may not be worn during the school day

OTHER POINTS TO NOTE:

Hair ties: all girls must wear hair neat and tidy off the face at all times. If this is not the case, hair ties will be sold to girls at the cost of 50p.

Jewellery: only jewellery allowed is a watch, discreet stud earrings, one religious symbol eg cross or Star of David.

Make-up: no make-up is permitted, including nail varnish

EQUIPMENT FOR SCHOOL:

Scientific calculator: as recommended by and obtainable from the mathematics dept.

Pencil case & contents: to include one 15cm and one 30cm ruler, pair of compasses and protractor, set of coloured pencils and a fountain pen with washable blue cartridges. These items may be obtained from the school library. No correction fluid is permitted.

School bag: every girl should possess a school bag, which should be strong, weatherproof and have proper fastenings. Rucksack style bags are recommended.

USB stick: it would be useful for each girl to have a USB stick – available from the Library

Bicycles: We strongly urge cyclists to wear a cycling helmet. Bicycles should be marked and locked when left in cycle racks during the day.

ALL CLOTHING, PE EQUIPMENT, WATCHES, MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS, CALCULATORS AND THEIR CASES MUST BE CLEARLY NAMED.
