25 candidates obtained A* grades in all their subjects.

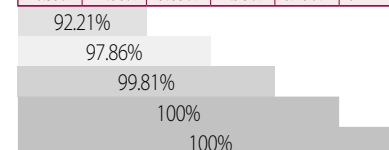

Higher Education Guidance and Careers

Careers education and guidance starts in Year 8 and is carried through to the Sixth Form. Within this programme, students assess their interests, their strengths and weaknesses and the requirements for entering different professions. They are also prepared for work experience placements where appropriate in Year 11. All students are interviewed individually by a member of the Careers team in Year 11 and Lower 6. The Careers library is open during the school day. A Morrisby psychometric profile and follow up interview with a careers advisor is offered to girls at the end of Year 10. There is a team of well qualified and dedicated staff to give advice and guidance to all girls at various stages where choices are made, right through to university applications. Considerable help is given with the UCAS application process. There is a Higher Education evening for girls and parents; Old Girls come back and discuss their courses, and practice interviews are arranged. Specialist advice on applications to universities overseas is also available.
