Scholarships at St Helen's

At St Helen and St Katharine we believe that one of our most important roles as a school is encouraging our students to do their best, rewarding their achievements and celebrating their individual talents, both academically and beyond the classroom.

Being a scholar gives students the opportunity to pursue their personal aspirations with the support of staff. Scholars regularly discuss their progress and future goals with staff mentors, ensuring their enthusiasm and commitment is nurtured and appreciated. They are also expected to take the lead and show initiative in the area for which they have been recognised, as well as offering inspiration and encouragement to peers and the whole school community.





Applying for scholarships

All scholarships are open to both internal and external candidates and are awarded in the academic year before they come into effect.

Students may hold scholarships in more than one area (the second being of honorary rather than financial value) although two

non-academic awards cannot be held by the same individual. Scholarships are not subject to means testing and vary in duration and value.
