Year 8 history trip to the Black Country Museum, Birmingham

We will be taking all students in Year 8 to the Black Country Museum, Birmingham on Thursday 28 June. The day will consist of guided tours around the museum with two workshops on the Victorian school and Victorian mines. This trip relates to the topic on the Industrial Revolution which the students have been covering this term.

We will be leaving school at 8am by coach and returning by 5pm. Please note that we will be setting off before the school buses arrive at school therefore please could you make separate arrangements for your daughter to get to school in the morning by 7.45am. The students will be in time to catch the late bus home but if your daughter does not normally travel on the late bus please email admin@jointbus.co.uk to ensure a place for her.

The charge for this trip is £22 and this will be added to the school bill. Students should wear comfortable home clothes which they don't mind getting a little dirty, trainers or non-slip shoes and bring a light-weight waterproof for the mines tour. There will be a school packed lunch provided for all students but there may be an opportunity for your daughter to purchase some traditional fish and chips (not suitable for vegetarians or vegans) or souvenirs. For this, she will need no more than £10.
